Fiela se kind 2015 set in nineteenth century rural africa fiela s child tells the gripping story of fiela komoetie and a white three year old child benjamin whom she finds crying on her doorstep for nine years fiela raises benjamin as one of her own children but when census takers discover benjamin they send him to an illiterate white family of woodcutters who claim him as their son what follows is benjamin s search for his identity and the fundamental changes affecting the white and black families who claim him everything a novel can be convincing thought provoking upsetting unforgettable and timeless grace ingoldby new statesman fiela s child is a parade that broadens and humanizes our understanding of the conflicts still affecting south africa today francis levy new york times book review a powerful creation of time and place with dark threads of destiny and oppression and its roots in the almost biblical soil of a storyteller s art christopher wordsworth the guardian the characters in the novel live and breathe and the landscape is so brightly painted that the trees birds elephants and rivers of old south africa are characters themselves a book not to miss kirkus reviews

Fiela's Child 1992-09 poppie s contented childhood ends when she marries moves to cape town and later is forced to resettle apart from her husband the drama of the soweto and sharpeville uprisings are vividly portrayed

Poppie Nongena 1986 an analytic and historical perspective of literary texts to understand the position of domestic workers in south africa more than a million black south african women are domestic workers precariously situated between urban and rural areas rich and poor white and black these women are at once intimately connected and at a distant remove from the families they serve ena jansen shows that domestic worker relations in south africa were shaped by the institution of slavery establishing social hierarchies and patterns of behavior that persist today likefamily is an updated version of the award winning soos familie 2015 and the highly acclaimed 2016 dutch translation bijna familie

Like Family 2019-04-15 karoliena kapp is a child of the forest born into a community of woodcutters she is given the advantage of a good education but it serves only to heighten her growing realisation that because of the harsh injustices of poverty there is little hope for the woodcutters the day after her marriage to johannes himself of woodcutter stock she realises that she has made the wrong choice she may have escaped from the poverty of the forest but she has exchanged her freedom for a cage alone and afraid she leaves her husband and takes the road back to the forest

Drama for Secondary Schools 1974 high schools are jungles and there are rules for surviving all teenagers need to know these rules they re pretty simple never let your mom drive you to school in her dressing gown never let her comment on your facebook page never let her choose your clothes especially not your underwear common sense right thirteen year old ben smith flying under the radar at st david s a rugby worshipping school knew all the rules his mom knew them too that s why he trusted her to be cool but then ben broke the most important rule of all never tell your mom stuff first he spilled the beans then she did and all hell broke loose ben wasn t ben benno ben dude anymore he was the rat the weasel the sneak he was snitch snitch is the award winning book of the 2017 m e r prize for the best english or afrikaans youth novel *Dreamforest* 2012-10-02 billy is one of four teens chosen as the finalists in a competition to spend a long weekend in the kruger park but on their first night in the bushveld they run into a group of rhino poachers and land in grave danger who is the mysterious boy and the anonymous hornblower will they help the four friends expose the villains and save the rhino

Drama for Students 2008 includes the plays african gothic good heavens and breathing in a farm lies in ruin and with mother and father now gone a brother and sister face eviction by an officious lawyer abandoned they endlessly enact the rituals of punishment once visited upon them by their parents widely regarded as a milestone in south african theatre the multi award winning play african gothic tells the story of their final dance macabre despite overwhelming critical acclaim it was also fiercely condemned by afrikaans conservatives as being a subversive portrayal of repression good heavens is a comedy thriller with the dark poetic heart of a folk tale two spinster sisters with their ailing mother and simple minded brother await the annual visit of their youngest sister deeply envious of her beauty and youth they hatch a diabolical plot to rid themselves of her forever in breathing in on a stormy night in the last bitter months of the second anglo boer war a seriously wounded general and his faithful adjutant encounter a mysterious woman and her seductive other wordly daughter and are confronted with the subtle methods of survival these women have been forced to adopt accustomed to the rigours of war the corageous adjutant now faces a terrible choice

JSD, Jamaica School of Drama 1986 sarah lotz internationally acclaimed author of the three and day four describes the mark as an entrancing truly original novel packed with twists you won t see coming and a heroine that breaks the mould unputdownable in the future the world has flipped ravaged by the conflagration the state of mangeria is a harsh place where the sun beats down people s lives are run by a heartless elite and law is brutally enforced a mark at the base of the spine controls each person s destiny the machine decides what work you will do and who your life partner will be juliet seven ettie will soon turn 15 and her life as a drudge will begin her fate mate mate will be chosen like everyone else her future is marked by the numbers on her spine but ettie decides to challenge her destiny and in so doing she fulfills the prophecy that was spoken of before she even existed

Beginning Drama, 11-14 1998 outside a south african town a silent woman ruth goes through her self imposed rituals a child s crib strapped to her back an observer simon who has loved ruth since childhood tells her story tshepang was inspired by the horrifying rape in 2001 of a nine month old child the child tshepang gave her name to lara foot newton s award winning play though it is also based on twenty thousand true stories the number of child rapes estimated to occur in south africa each year having premiered in amsterdam in june 2003 tshepang opened at the gate theatre london in september 2004 book jacket
