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Le Sentier des Caps de Charlevoix 2014 rather than a natural frontier between natural enemies this book approaches the english channel as a shared space which mediated the multiple relations between france and england in the long eighteenth century in both a metaphorical and a material sense instead of arguing that britain s insularity kept it spatially and intellectually segregated from the continent renaud morieux focuses on the channel as a zone of contact the narrow sea was a shifting frontier between states and a space of exchange between populations this richly textured history shows how the maritime border was imagined by cartographers and legal theorists delimited by state administrators and transgressed by migrants it approaches french and english fishermen smugglers and merchants as transnational actors whose everyday practices were entangled the variation of scales of analysis enriches theoretical and empirical understandings of anglo french relations and reassesses the question of britain s deep historical connections with europe

Mer et montagne dans la culture européenne 2011 this collection of papers by an international chort of contributors explores the nature of the maritime connections that appear to have existed in the transmanche english channel zone during later prehistory organised into three themes movement and identity in the transmanche zone travel and exchange identity and landscape the papers seek to articulate notions of frontier mobility and identity from the end of the 3rd to the beginning of the

1st millennium bc a time when the archaeological evidence suggests that the sea facilitated connections between peoples on both sides of the channel rather than acting as a barrier as it is so often perceived today recent decades have since a massive increase in large scale excavation programmes on either side of the channel in advance of major infra structure and urban development resulting in the acquisition of huge complex new datasets enabling new insights into later prehistoric life in this crucially important region papers consider the role of several key archaeologists in transforming our appreciation of the connectivity of the sea in prehistory consider the extent to which the channel zone developed into a closely unified cultural zone during later bronze age in terms of communities that serviced the movement of artefacts across the channel with both sides sharing widely in the same artefacts and social practices examine funerary practices and settlement evidence and consider the relationship between communities in social cultural and ideological terms and consider mechanisms for the transmission of ideas and how they may be reflected in the archaeological record brings together leading scholars from the uk and northern europe in a thought provoking and revealing new examination of the relationship between communities in the transmanche zone in the bronze and iron ages the premise is that the english channel was a conduit for connectivity and exchange of ideas artefacts and social practices and rather than a barrier or frontier that had to be overcome before such connections could be fostered

Annual Report 1908 the nineteenth century novelist george sand is most famous today for her tumultuous love life and trouser wearing days in paris but she achieved major commercial and critical success in her day and has gradually made her way back into the literary canon mainly known for her pastoral tales and allegedly simplistic idealism sand in fact

produced around ninety novels which experiment with a wide range of themes forms and aesthetic models this book offers the first study of vision in sand s works it argues that rather than rejecting reality in favour of the ideal sand integrates physical observation with internal forms of seeing such as the imagination and visionary insights the study maintains that sand s understanding of vision provides the basis for her distinctive style and challenges conventional categorisations of the novel in this period
