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of women the vast majority of whom are not mentioned in the standard catalogs of flute literature a carefully compiled study the volume examines the quantity variety and scope of women s work in this genre and includes composers from more than forty countries spanning three centuries it contains works for solo flute duets flute and piano concertos woodwind quintets other chamber ensembles or any work that employs soloistic use of the flute it also provides biographical information on the composers publishers availability of works and annotations on the works themselves all compositions are indexed by title and by instrumentation and publishers and contemporary composers are listed with current addresses to facilitate the ordering of music the first published volume of its kind this unusual work will draw attention to valuable and unknown repertoire in this genre and provide the opportunity for women s works to be heard more often it will be useful in all university music libraries and conservatories and it will be a valuable resource for professional flutists teachers of flute and researcher in women s studies

url areditions com rr rra a072 html george frederick bristow 1825 98 american composer conductor teacher and performer was a pillar of the new york musical community for the second half of the nineteenth century his participation in an important mid century battle of words between william henry fry and the journalist richard storrs willis and concerning a lack of support for american composers by the philharmonic society has unfortunately overshadowed his accomplishments as a composer which were significant bristow is remembered today primarily for his opera rip van winkle 1855 and oratorio daniel 1866 but he was also a skillful and productive composer of orchestral music one of only a handful of american orchestral composers active at mid century bristow wrote his symphony no 2 jullien in 1853 it is a substantial work in four movements scored for the standard orchestra of the early nineteenth century and strongly influenced by the personal styles of beethoven and mendelssohn whose works were performed regularly by the philharmonic society the symphony is skillfully crafted melodious and intrinsically worthy work of musical artistry

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it was named to honor the french conductor louis jullien who visited the united states in 1853 54 with an unparalleled orchestra while in the united states jullien both commissioned and performed american works including this symphony his support served as the catalyst for the fry willis battle the introductory essay to this symphony examines bristow s career the composition of orchestral music in america at mid century and jullien s role in the musical battle the edition makes available for the first time an important work that has been undeservedly forgotten for over 150 years

as the twentieth century draws to a close igor stravinsky s stature as one of its master musicians is indisputable his active career as a composer covered fully two thirds of the century from the songs and the symphony he wrote as a pupil of rimsky korsakov in st petersburg to the music on sacred themes he produced as an old man in los angeles between these early and late works stretched a creative life that included triumphs of the ballets russes such as the firebird petrushka and the rite of spring children s piano pieces works based on greek myth and on russian

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peasant theatre new approaches to concerto grosso form as well as to ragtime liturgies as well as sketches for circus band reworkings of ideas from the baroque and explorations of possibilities no one had dreamed of stravinsky s influence is incalculable and like his output extraordinarily wide in range it has been felt by composers from debussy and schoenberg to those who had not yet been heard from when he died in 1971 in his long and honored life he came into contact with people from tchaikovsky and ravel to t s eliot and w h auden from benito mussolini to john f kennedy from picasso nijinsky and cocteau to louis b mayer in this new study paul griffiths surveys stravinsky s vastly variegated life and output in one chronological sweep showing how certain basic images and principles emerge again and again in the music but also emphasizing his capacity to start afresh to confront us not with one stravinsky but with many since stravinsky s death publication of his correspondence and other material has made possible a deeper investigation of his creative methods profiting from this andexploring the works both as individual creations and as elements in a wider context paul griffiths s book is a new and stimulating guide to stravinsky s life and music

candace bailey s exploration of the intertwining worlds of music and gender shows how young southern women pushed the boundaries of respectability to leave their unique mark on a patriarchal society before 1861 a strictly defined code of behavior allowed a southern woman to identify herself as a lady through her accomplishments in music drawing and writing among other factors music permeated the lives of southern women and they learned appropriate participation through instruction at home and at female training institutions a belle s primary venue was the parlor where she could demonstrate her usefulness in the domestic circle by providing comfort and serving to enhance social gatherings through her musical performances often by playing the piano or singing the southern lady performed in public only on the rarest of occasions though she might attend public performances by women an especially talented lady who composed music for a broader audience would do so anonymously so that her reputation would remain unsullied the tumultuous civil war years provided an opportunity for southern women to envision and attempt new ways to make themselves useful to

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the broader public society while continuing their domestic responsibilities and taking on new ones young women also tested the boundaries of propriety in a variety of ways in a broad break with the past musical ladies began giving public performances to raise money for the war effort some women published patriotic confederate music under their own names supporting their cause and claiming public ownership for their creations bailey explores these women s lives and analyzes their music through their move from private to public performance and publication southern ladies not only expanded concepts of social acceptability but also gained a valued sense of purpose music and the southern belle places these remarkable women in their social context providing compelling insight into southern culture and the intricate ties between a lady s identity and the world of music augmented by incisive analysis of musical compositions and vibrant profiles of composers this volume is the first of its kind making it an essential read for devotees of civil war and southern history gender studies and music
