## How Prophecy Works

there is a longstanding scholarly debate on the nature of prophecy in ancient israel until now no study has based itself on the semantics of the hebrew lexeme nābî' prophet this investigation by william l kelly discusses the nature and function of prophecy in the corpus of the hebrew book of jeremiah it analyses all occurrences of nābî' in jeremiah and performs a close reading of three primary texts jeremiah 1 4 19 23 9 40 and 27 1 28 17 the result is a detailed explanation of how prophecy works and what it meant to call someone a nābî' in ancient israel combining the results of the semantic analysis and close readings the study reaches conclusions for six main areas of study 1 the function and nature of prophecy 2 dreams and visions 3 being sent 4 prophets priests and cult 5 salvation and doom and 6 legitimacy and authority these conclusions explain the conceptual categories related to nābî' in the corpus i then situate these findings in two current debates one on the definition of nābî' and one on cultic prophecy this study contributes to critical scholarship on prophecy in the ancient world on the book of jeremiah and on prophets in ancient israel it is the first major study to analyse nābî' based on its semantic associations it adds to a growing consensus which understands prophecy as a form of divination contrary to some trends in jeremiah scholarship this work demonstrates the importance of a close reading of the masoretic hebrew text this study uses a method of a general nature which can be applied to other texts thus there are significant implications for further research on prophecy and prophetic literature

in recent years an interest in empire s has emerged in assyriology old testament hebrew bible studies and in other areas of the study of the ancient world collaborative research projects are devoted to questions of empire and imperialism and the prophets of israel and judah and the books named after them are explored as agents in the contexts of the empires of their times to some degree all of this may be seen as a revival of the intense interest which the works of oswald spengler arnold toynbee and karl

the levitical day of atonement was a day of penitence confession and judgment for israelites of loyal character and a day of covenant renewal for the nation of israel on this day sin was removed from the tabernacle through the application of sacrificial blood to its altars and compartments as well as by the dismissal of the goat for azazel which carried all the community s sin to a barren land as it became ingrained in the veil of jewish consciousness the day of atonement underwent a process of abstraction over many centuries leading up to second temple times when the most holy place lay devoid of the ark of the covenant and its mercy seat continuing to reverberate in the jewish imaginaire the day of atonement was received by the authors of the new testament including john of patmos to whom its sacrificial typology provided irresistible motifs which they used to proclaim the christ event by utilizing a coherent intertextual approach this book explores how john wove the day of atonement into the colorful literary tapestry of revelation
