E Partirai, Mia Vita 2003 documents the first hand experiences in the holocaust of the sephardim from greece the balkans north africa libya cos and rhodes the sephardim suffered devastation during the holocaust but this facet of history is poorly documented what literature exists on the sephardim in the holocaust focuses on specific countries such as yugoslavia and greece or on specific cities such as salonika and many of these works are not available in english the sephardim in the holocaust a forgotten people embraces the sephardim of all the countries shattered by the holocaust and pays tribute to the memory of the more than 160 000 sephardim who perished isaac jack lévy and rosemary lévy zumwalt draw on a wealth of archival sources family history isaac and his family were expelled from rhodes in 1938 and more than one hundred fifty interviews conducted with survivors during research trips to belgium canada france greece israel mexico the netherlands the former yugoslavia and the united states lévy follows the sephardim from athens corfu cos macedonia rhodes salonika and the former yugoslavia to auschwitz the authors chronicle the interminable cruelty of the camps from the initial selections to the grisly work of the sonderkommandos inside the crematoria detailing the distinctive challenges the sephardim faced with their differences in language physical appearance and pronunciation of hebrew all of which set them apart from the ashkenazim they document courageous sephardic revolts especially those by greek jews which involved intricate planning sequestering of gunpowder and complex coordination and communication between ashkenazi and sephardic inmates all done in the strictest of secrecy and they follow a number of sephardic survivors who took refuge in albania with the benevolent assistance of muslims and christians who opened their doors to give sanctuary and traces the fate of the approximately 430 000 jews from morocco algiers tunisia and libya from 1939 through the end of the war the author s intention is to include the sephardim in the shared tragedy with the ashkenazim and others the result is a much needed accessible and viscerally moving account of the sephardim s unique experience of the holocaust

A General History of Music, from the Earliest Ages to the Present Period 2020 translation and commentary are often associated with institutions and patronage but in italy around the time of dante widespread vernacular translation was mostly on the spontaneous initiative of individuals while dante is usually the starting point for histories of vernacular translation in europe this book demonstrates that the divine comedy places itself in opposition to a vast vernacular literature already in circulation among its readers alison cornish explores the anxiety of vernacularization as expressed by translators and contemporary authors the prevalence of translation in religious experience the role of scribal mediation the influence of the italian reception of french literature on that literature and how translating into the vernacular became a project of nation building only after its virtual demise during the humanist period vernacular translation was a phenomenon with which all authors in thirteenth and fourteenth century europe from brunetto latini to giovanni boccaccio had to contend

Lorenzi.] Ital. & Eng 1851 this volume explores how italian institutions dealers critics and artists constructed a modern national identity for italy by exporting literally and figuratively contemporary art to the united states in key moments between 1929 and 1969 from artist fortunato depero opening his futurist house in new york city to critic germano celant launching arte povera in the united states raffaele bedarida examines the thick web of individuals and cultural environments beyond the two more canonical movements that shaped this project by interrogating standard narratives of italian fascist propaganda on the one hand and american cold war imperialism on the other this book establishes a more nuanced transnational approach the central thesis is that beyond the immediate aims of political propaganda and conquering a new market for italian art these art exhibitions publications and the critical discourse aimed at american audiences all reflected back on their makers they forced and helped italians define their own modernity in relation to the world s new dominant cultural and economic power the book will be of interest to scholars working in art history social history exhibition history and italian studies

Volume the First [-the Fourth!] 1867 one of wall street journal s ten best books of the year winner of the national jewish book awards for holocaust memoir and sephardic culture recipient of the jewish book council s natan notable book award winner of the sophie brody medal the remarkable story of ninety nine year old stella levi whose conversations with the author over the course of six years bring to life the vibrant world of jewish rhodes the deportation to auschwitz that extinguished ninety percent of her community and the resilience and wisdom of the woman who lived to tell the tale with nearly a century of life behind her stella levi had never before spoken in detail about her past then she met michael frank he came to her greenwich village apartment one saturday afternoon to ask her a question about the juderia the neighborhood on the greek island of rhodes where she d grown up in a jewish community that had thrived there for half a millennium neither of them could know this was the first of one hundred saturdays over the course of six years that they would spend in each other s company during these meetings stella traveled back in time to conjure what it felt like to come of age on this luminous legendary island in the eastern aegean which the italians conquered in 1912 began governing as an official colonial possession in 1923 and continued to administer even after the germans seized control in september 1943 the following july the germans rounded up all 1 700 plus residents of the juderia and sent them first by boat and then by train to auschwitz on what was the longest journey measured by both time and distance of any of the deportations ninety percent of them were murdered upon arrival probing and courageous candid and sly stella is a magical modern day scheherazade whose stories reveal what it was like to grow up in an extraordinary place in an extraordinary time and to construct a life after that place has vanished one hundred saturdays is a portrait of one of the last survivors drawn at nearly the last possible moment as well as an account of a tender and transformative friendship between storyteller and listener offering a powerful reminder that the ability to listen thoughtfully is a rare and significant gift the wall street journal

Otello, o, il moro di Venezia 2017-10-16 unique among early modern artists the baroque painter sculptor and architect gianlorenzo bernini was the subject of two monographic biographies published shortly after his death in 1680 one by the florentine connoisseur and writer filippo baldinucci 1682 and the second by bernini s son domenico 1713 this interdisciplinary collection of essays by historians of art and literature marks the first sustained examination of the two biographies first and foremost as texts a substantial introductory essay considers each biography s author genesis and foundational role in the study of bernini nine essays combining art historical research with insights from philology literary history and art and literary theory offer major new insights into the multifarious connections between biography art history and aesthetics inviting readers to rethink bernini s life art and milieu contributors are eraldo bellini heiko damm john d lyons sarah mcphée tomaso montanari rudolf preimesberger robert williams and the editors maarten delbeke is assistant professor of architectural history and theory at the universities of ghent and leiden formerly the scott opler fellow in architectural history at worcester college oxford he is the author of several articles and a forthcoming book on seicento art and theory evonne levy is associate professor of the history of art at the university of toronto she is also the author of *propaganda and the jesuit baroque* 2004
