maggie and john anderson were successful african american professionals raising two daughters in a tony suburb of chicago but they felt uneasy over their good fortune most african americans live in economically starved neighborhoods black wealth is about one tenth of white wealth and black businesses lag behind businesses of all other racial groups in every measure of success one problem is that black consumers unlike consumers of other ethnicities choose not to support black owned businesses at the same time most of the businesses in their communities are owned by outsiders on january 1 2009 the andersons embarked on a year long public pledge to buy black they thought that by taking a stand the black community would be mobilized to exert its economic might they thought that by exposing the issues americans of all races would see that economically empowering black neighborhoods benefits society as a whole instead blacks refused to support their own and others condemned their experiment drawing on economic research and social history as well as her personal story maggie anderson shows why the black economy continues to suffer and issues a call to action to all of us to do our part to reverse this trend

a comprehensive look at four of the most famous problems in mathematics tales of impossibility recounts the intriguing story of the renowned problems of antiquity four of the most famous and studied questions in the history of mathematics first posed by the ancient greeks these compass and straightedge problems squaring the circle trisecting an angle doubling the cube and inscribing regular polygons in a circle have served as ever present muses for mathematicians for more than two millennia david richeson follows the trail of these problems to show that ultimately their proofs which demonstrated the impossibility of solving them using only a compass and straightedge depended on and resulted in the growth of mathematics richeson investigates how celebrated luminaries including euclid archimedes viète descartes newton and gauss labored to understand these problems and how many major mathematical discoveries were related to their explorations although the problems were based in geometry their resolutions were not and had to wait until the nineteenth century when mathematicians had developed the theory of real and complex numbers analytic geometry algebra and calculus pierre wantzel a little known mathematician and ferdinand von lindemann through his work on pi finally determined the problems were impossible to solve along the way richeson provides entertaining anecdotes connected to the problems such as how the indiana state legislature passed a bill setting an incorrect value for pi and how leonardo da vinci made elegant



contributions in his own study of these problems taking readers from the classical period to the present tales of impossibility chronicles how four unsolvable problems have captivated mathematical thinking for centuries

responsible for almost everything that went wrong in the new world here finally is a book that will radically change our interpretation of the man and his mission scholar carol delaney claims that the true motivation for columbus s voyages is very different from what is commonly accepted she argues that he was inspired to find a western route to the orient not only to obtain vast sums of gold for the spanish crown but primarily to help fund a new crusade to take jerusalem from the muslims a goal that sustained him until the day he died rather than an avaricious glory hunter delaney reveals columbus as a man of deep passion patience and religious conviction delaney sets the stage by describing the tumultuous events that had beset europe in the years leading up to columbus s birth the failure of multiple crusades to keep jerusalem in christian hands the devastation of the black plague and the schisms in the church then just two years after his birth the sacking of constantinople by the ottomans barred christians from the trade route to the east and the pilgrimage route to jerusalem columbus s belief that he was destined to play a decisive role in the retaking of jerusalem was the force that drove him to petition the spanish monarchy to fund his journey even in the face of ridicule about his idea of sailing west to reach the east columbus and the quest for jerusalem is based on extensive archival research trips to spain and italy to visit important sites in columbus s life story and a close reading of writings from his day it recounts the drama of the four voyages bringing the trials of ocean navigation vividly to life and showing columbus for the master navigator that he was delaney offers not an apologist s take but a clear eyed thought provoking and timely reappraisal of the man and his legacy she depicts him as a thoughtful interpreter of the native cultures that he and his men encountered and unfolds the tragic story of how his initial attempts to establish good relations with the natives turned badly sour culminating in his being brought back to spain as a prisoner in chains putting columbus back into the context of his times rather than viewing him through the prism of present day perspectives on colonial conquests delaney shows him to have been neither a greedy imperialist nor a quixotic adventurer as he has lately been depicted but a man driven by an abiding religious passion
