a pitched roof is a roof comprising a sloping surface or surfaces with an angle of usually over 20 degrees it is a bi fold bi planer roof with a ridge at its highest point to be more specific a pitched roof requires a pitch of more than 10 degrees or a roof with two slopes that meet at a central ridge pitched roofs offer a more
